Provision of the Faculty

Provision of the faculty of Business, Law and Social Sciences

The faculty of Business, Law and Social Sciences is the institute's educational structural unit that provides the implementation of bachelor's educational programs; the faculty is accountable to the Rector and Academic Council of the Institution;

The Faculty operates in accordance with the Law of Georgia, internal regulations of the institution and this provision.

The major aims of the faculty are:

- To create the appropriate conditions for students and the academic/invited personnel for learning, teaching and scientific researches; ensure the possibility of getting future-oriented education directed to the business law and social sciences, relevant to the modern standards; continuous care about improvement of the conditions for training process and the scientific work;
- To prepare the cadres who will have the education and the skills relevant to the requirements of the civil society, who will be moral and will have the civil self-awareness values;
- Maximum satisfaction of obtaining higher education with taking into consideration a person's interests and abilities;
- To realize a person's intellectual potential, to develop the person's creative skills and to prepare the competitive cadres, with the modern competencies, for the labor market;
- Attraction of new, well-qualified academic scientific /invited personnel with the direction of business, law and science for raising the competitiveness of the institute and for development of the state;
- > To provide the mobility of the institute's students and the academic/invited personnel and etc.

The objectives of faculty are:

- > To attract the well-qualified cadres with the direction of business, law and social sciences;
- > Promoting integration into the European space of education and extension of mobility;
- > To develop the students' professional skills oriented to the labor market and etc.
