#### **Requirements for the electronic copy of the report**

✓ The title of the file and the subject of the email must correspond to the surname and first name of the participant (for example, Polukhina Alina report);

- Prepared in Microsoft Word 6.0 and higher for Windows, permitted extensions \*.doc, \*.docx;
- amount of pages 3-5 pages of A4 format;
- page margins: top, bottom, right 15 mm, left 20 mm;
- font Times New Roman. font-size 14;
- line spacing 1,5.

References in the text are given in round brackets indicating the following: author's last name - comma - year of publication - comma - citation page (Bibikov, 2010, p. 25). References to several sources are given simultaneously through semicolons (Bibikov, 2010; Petrov, 2007; Ivanov, 2015), pages are indicated if necessary. The sources are listed alphabetically and are not numbered. The report must contain references to foreign sources.

At the end, a list of references formatted according to APA referencing style should be given.
