English-Taught Bachelor's Degree Program in Computer Science

- Duration: 4 years
- Tuition Fee: Equivalent of USD 4,500 in GEL per academic year

Visa Requirements

Applicants intending to study at New Higher Education Institute – NewUni are required to apply for a **long-term (Type D) immigration visa** for study purposes.

To apply for the visa, the applicant must obtain an **official admission (enrolment) letter** issued by New Higher Education Institute – NewUni.

Timeframes:

- **Admission procedure:** up to 3 weeks
- **Visa procedure:** up to 4 weeks

Admission Procedures

Application and Registration Stages

Stage 1: Registration

The applicant completes a **simple online application form**.

Stage 2: Submission of Documents

The applicant must submit the following documents:

- A biometric photograph (3x4);
- A document (or certified copy) confirming completion of full general secondary education or its equivalent, obtained abroad or in Georgia under a foreign or international program recognized by Georgia;
- If the applicant's name or surname differs across submitted documents, an affidavit confirming personal identity must be provided;
- A document confirming English language proficiency at B2 level.

Note:

Internationally recognized and commonly accepted B2-level English language certificates include, but are not limited to:

- Cambridge Exam – B2 level
- CEFR B2 certificate
- IELTS – score 4.0
- BEC Preliminary
- TOEIC – 550
- TOEFL iBT – 42
- TOEFL ITP – 460, etc.

If the submitted certificate is not included in the predefined list, its validity will be assessed in consultation with a field expert.

Applicants who have studied in English for at least one year or whose native language is English are exempt from the requirement to submit an English language certificate or take an English test.

➤ **Stage 3: Interview**

- ✓ The interview is conducted by a representative of the International Relations Office;
- ✓ The interview is held via electronic communication platforms such as Google Meet, Zoom, or similar;
- ✓ During the interview, the applicant's motivation, communication skills, and ability to understand and respond in English are assessed. Additional information may be provided if necessary;
- ✓ In the event that the interview cannot be conducted due to technical issues on the applicant's side (e.g., internet connectivity problems), the International Relations Office will make a decision and send interview questions and instructions to the applicant in writing.

➤ **Stage 4: Internal Examinations (Online)**

Upon meeting the selection criteria, the applicant is required to take:

- ✓ An online mathematics test, administered in English and based on predefined assessment criteria;
- ✓ An English language test (if required), which assesses all four language skills—writing, reading, listening, and speaking, as well as vocabulary and grammar. To confirm competency, the applicant must achieve a minimum score of 50 + 1 points.

Additional Notes

- ✓ Upon successful completion of the interview and/or testing stages, a conditional admission/enrolment letter is issued;
- ✓ Following the initiation of tuition fee payment, the official enrolment procedures are completed within one month. The applicant will receive an official invitation letter based on an order issued by the Ministry of Education, Science and Youth of Georgia;
- ✓ After the Ministry issues the enrolment order, official invitation letters are sent to successfully admitted students.
